

Call for Fellows of the EuroMed Research Business Institute

The Executive Board of the EuroMed Research Business Institute recognizes and awards through its Academy (EuroMed Academy of Business – EMAB) Scholars, Researchers and Professionals who excel in their respective field. Fellowship Status is granted upon election as Fellow by the Executive Board upon recommendation of a committee of peers (the Review Committee). Consideration for election to Fellowship is open to those members who are recognized as having leadership roles in Business or Management research and/or Practice.

Please note that only Fellows can nominate themselves (or be nominated by others) or vote during the elections for the positions of Vice Presidents and other Executives at EMRBI. The elections for two additional Vice Presidents will take place in January.

Fellowship Ranks

- 1. Senior Fellow SF EMAB
- 2. Fellow F EMAB
- 3. Associate Fellow AF EMAB
- 4. Student Fellow SF EMAB

Benefits

Fellows are entitled to:

- Refer to themselves in public statements, documents, business cards, published research papers, email communication and résumés as "Fellow of the EuroMed Academy of Business and adding the acronym (SF EMAB, F EMAB, AF EMAB, M EMAB) or SM EMAB) to their other credentials;
- Use in email and other communication the logo of the Academy next to their credentials;
- Nominate themselves (or be nominated by others) for the positions of Vice Presidents and other Executives at EMRBI;
- Vote at the elections for the new Vice Presidents and other Executives at EMRBI;
- Gaining international recognition as a scholar and/or practitioner;
- Extensive networking opportunities, including influential contacts, including
 with seminal academics and leading practitioners, that will help you create
 and/or advance a career in academia and/or business;

- Through sharing with and taking feedback from peers, gaining opportunities to enhance the quality and impact of your research in the area of business;

Fellowship Criteria

The criteria for each rank are listed below. These criteria are given as a general guide, but each application will be considered on its own merits. Detailed guidelines of the elements included under Research & Publications, Scholarly Work, Teaching & Consulting and Service and Contributions are provided at the end of this document.

Senior Fellow (SF EMAB)

Candidates should have established record and reputation for research, scholarly work and a distinguished record of teaching or consulting.

Criteria:

- A Doctorate Degree
- Evidence for good and solid record of research and teaching experience.
- Evidence of consulting and scholarly work excellence may be an advantage.
- Continued research productivity with publications in international under citation refereed journals, books and conference proceedings
- Evidence of instructing and/or promoting research through projects or supervision of research staff or graduate students
- Professional service with contributions to the promotion of teaching and administrative work of their institution as well as service to the profession and the community
- Outstanding involvement in EMRBI, EMAB, EMRC and EMJB activities.

Fellow (F EMAB)

Candidates should have a high level of competence in research in their respective academic field, should have demonstrated significant research, teaching, consulting and scholarly work leading ideally to international recognition in their field and show promise of continued productivity, and competence to direct and promote research.

Criteria:

- A Doctorate Degree
- Evidence for good and solid achievements in their professional, teaching or research career
- Evidence of consulting and scholarly work excellence may be advantage.
- Good record of publications in international refereed journals, books and conference proceedings
- High involvement in any EMRBI activities, including EMAB, EMRC and EMJB activities.

Associate Fellow (AF EMAB)

Candidates should exhibit achievements in research, teaching, consulting and scholarly work excellence.

Criteria:

- A Doctorate Degree or extensive industrial/ research/ consulting/ teaching experience
- Evidence for a successful professional, teaching or research career.
- Involvement in EMRBI, EMAB, EMRC and EMJB activities.

EMRBI Student Fellow (SM)

Candidate should satisfy the following:

Criteria:

- Bachelor, Masters and Doctorate candidates
- Exhibit research potential and scholarly activities

Detailed Guidelines of the Elements Included under Research and Publications, Scholarly Work, Teaching, Service and Contributions

The items under the four following categories are only indicative and neither limiting nor exhaustive. Candidates are <u>not</u> expected to have contributed in <u>all</u> items under a category.

Research and Publications

- Referred Journal articles
- Books written published by recognized publisher and/or received positive comments in referred journal
- Chapters/cases/articles in books
- Conference proceedings
- Citations of published work
- o Academic Awards.
- Grants received (amount, duration, competitive or non-competitive, role, etc.)

Scholarly Work

- o Journal editorship
- Journal guest special editions
- o Membership in journal advisory/editorial boards
- Membership in professional associations
- Supervision of theses and doctoral dissertations
- o Book, journal and conference paper reviews
- o Conference chair or member of the organizing committee
- Conference session chair or discussant
- o International visiting appointments
- o Involvement in international or local research centers

- Honors and distinctions received
- o Involvement in EMRBI, EMAB, EMRC and EMJB activities

Teaching and Consulting

- Teaching excellence
- o Innovative methods in teaching
- o Consulting to organizations and entrepreneurs
- o Conducting Executive Workshop within EMRBI or EMAB

Service and Contributions

- Academic or industry position(s) held
- o Contribution to EMRBI, EMAB, EMRC and EMJB activities
- Mentoring of new faculty
- o Articles in newspapers and professional magazines
- Community service

Fellowship fees (annual)

•	Fellows and Associate Fellow	€ 200,00
•	Student Fellow	€ 150,00
•	Hard copy of the EuroMed Journal of Business (optional)	€ 95,00

Fellows will be granted a 20% subsidy on the Annual EMAB conference fee.

Procedure

Applications are accepted at October of each consequent year.

The following documents should be submitted electronically at <u>tsoukat@staff.teicrete.gr</u> (cc: <u>EMRBI@unic.ac.cy</u>).

- 1. Fellowship Application
- 2. A recent detailed CV
- 3. Publications' list (if not included in item 2 above)

The EMAB's review committee will review the applications and prepare a recommendation report.

The recommendation needs to be ratified by EMRBI's Executive Board.

The decision is announced to the applicant.

Special Provisions

For the two highest Fellowships (Fellow and Senior Fellow) appointments may be limited and determined by the Executive Board.

Exceptional cases (people that do not fill the requirements) are subject to the discretion of the Executive Board
